Noting :

- 05.(a) To note the letter bearing D.O. F. No. 87-1/2014(SU-I) dated 15.05.2015 received from the Secretary, University Grants Commission, New Delhi pertaining to "Swachh Bharat Abhiyan".

Resolution: The Executive Council of Vidyasagar University noted the letter bearing D.O. F. No. 87-1/2014(SU-I) dated 15.05.2015 received from the Secretary, University Grants Commission, New Delhi stating that in the earlier letter dated 24.02.2015 regarding "Swachh Bharat Abhiyan" wherein it was desired that each State University should adopt five villages to transform them into 'Adarsh Villages'. In connection with this, the Secretary has requested to send the action taken report for implementation of the said Abhiyan conducted by the Vidyasagar University.

After thorough discussion on the letter received from the Secretary, University Grants Commission, New Delhi pertaining to "Swachh Bharat Abhiyan" it was resolved that the National Service Scheme Unit of Vidyasagar University be requested to take further process in this regard.

Discussion: 06(a)

To discuss the matter regarding granting of duty leave to the non-teaching employees who had been deputed by the University and also appointed by the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examination Board for performing the duty of WBJEEM-2015 held on 5th & 6th May, 2015 respectively.

Resolution : The Executive Council of Vidyasagar University noted that some of the non-teaching employees of this University performed the duties as Board Representative for WBJEEM-2015 held in the working days on 5th & 6th May, 2015 respectively. The Executive Council also noted that the concerned employees were deputed by the University and subsequently appointed by the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examination Board for this purpose. The Executive Council noted further that now the concerned non-teaching employees have claimed for granting duty leave on those days.

After thorough discussion on the matter regarding granting of duty leave to the non-teaching employees who had been deputed by the University and also appointed by the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examination Board for

performing the duty of WBJEEM-2015 held on 5th & 6th May, 2015 respectively, it was resolved that the non-teaching employees who performed the duties of WBJEEM-2015 on those days be granted duty leave as a special case.

- 06(b) To place before the Executive Council of Vidyasagar University the letter bearing No. 503(26)-Edn(U)/1U-39/15 dated 20.05.2015 received from the Joint Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Higher Education Department, University Branch along with the proposal from HLL Limited for installation of Automated Vending Machine for Sanitary napkins for the girl students of the Universities.

Resolution: The Executive Council of Vidyasagar University noted the letter bearing No. 503(26)-Edn(U)/1U-39/15 dated 20.05.2015 received from the Joint Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Higher Education Department, stating that the HLL Limited, which is a Government of India enterprise, has come up with the proposal of installation of Automated Vending Machine for Sanitary napkins for the girl students of the Universities. In this connection he has informed us that the University may contact HLL directly without routing the matter through the Higher Education Department for further details, clarification and mode of execution of the project etc. The Executive Council noted further the detailed proposal submitted by HLL Limited in this regard.

After thorough discussion on the letter received from the Joint Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Higher Education Department and careful consideration of the proposal of HLL Limited for installation of Automated Vending Machine for Sanitary napkins for the girl students of the Universities, it was resolved that the proposal submitted by HLL Limited be accepted and further process for installation of the said machine in this University be taken immediately for this purpose. Resolved also that the Finance Officer and the University Engineer be requested to do the needful for further process in this regard.

- 06(c) To place before the Executive Council of Vidyasagar University, the letter dated NIL received from Shri Sudarsan Singh, Junior Assistant of Vidyasagar University pertaining to reply on the show cause letter regarding non-submission of undertaking due to late attendance at his duty in this University on 22.04.2015 and also violation of the order of the office superior.

Resolution: The Executive Council of Vidyasagar University noted that due to late attendance in the duty on 22.04.2015 at this University, Shri Sudarshan Singh, Junior Assistant of Vidyasagar University was asked to submit an undertaking framed by the University in this regard by his office superior before putting his signature in the attendance register. The Executive Council also noted that Shri Sing put his signature in the attendance register on that date violating the order of his office superior and refused to submit the undertaking for this purpose. The Executive Council noted further that in connection with the above as per the direction of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Shri Singh was issued the show cause notice due to insubordination. The Executive Council noted again the reply of the show case letter submitted by Shri Sudarshan Singh in this regard along with the observation of the Controller of Examinations(Actg.) along with the CCTV Footage.

After thorough discussion on the reply letter of show cause due to insubordination submitted by Shri Sudarshan Singh and careful consideration of the observation of the Controller of Examinations (Actg.) and CCTV Footage in this regard, it was resolved that the reply of show cause submitted by Shri Singh was false and dissatisfactory and also was unbecoming of an employee of this University. Resolved also that Shri Singh be censured not to repeat such practice in future.

- 06(d) To place before the Executive Council of Vidyasagar University, the Judgement passed by the Division Bench of Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta pertaining to extension of time for conclusion of the disciplinary proceedings initiated against Dr. Indrani Datta (Chaudhuri), Assistant Professor, Department of English, now under suspension.

Resolution: The EC members noted that the Hon'ble Division Bench vide its order dated 01.06.2015 directed as follows:

We extend the time peremptorily for one month from the date of receipt of the version of the appellant on the enquiry report and ask the appellant to cooperate with the University so that it could be concluded within the said period.

The application is thus disposed of. The appellant is granted liberty to submit her views on the report positively by Friday next.

It is unanimously resolved by the EC that the disciplinary proceedings initiated against Dr. Indrani Datta (Chaudhuri) be completed, within the time prescribed by the Hon'ble Appeal Court as above.

- 06(e) To consider the letters dated 27.05.2015 & 31.05.2015 received through e-mail from Dr. Indrani Datta (Chaudhuri), Assistant Professor, Department of English of this University, now under suspension, pertaining to different queries regarding applying for minor/major research projects under UGC scheme, promotion to the post of Senior Lecturer to that of Reader under the old regulations of UGC, participation in a Refresher Course as a student participant, applying for post-doctoral fellowships, enrollment in correspondence courses in human rights, degrees in law courses etc. during the period of her suspension.

Resolution: The aforesaid letters were taken up by the EC wherein it was decided that the University would forward the aforesaid letters of Dr. Indrani Datta (Chaudhuri) to the UGC and seek their opinion on the same. The UGC clarification on the issues thereafter be communicated to Dr. Datta (Chaudhuri).

- 06(f) To place before the Executive Council of Vidyasagar University the letters dated 25.05.2015 & 31.05.2015 respectively received through e-mail from Dr. Indrani Datta (Chaudhuri), Assistant Professor, Department of English, now under suspension, pertaining to her comments/observations/remarks on the Enquiry Report submitted by the Enquiry Officer constituted by EC based upon the Articles of Charges framed against Dr. Datta (Chaudhuri) vide Charge Sheet bearing Reference No. VU/R/7EC/971/2014 dated 23.07.2014.

Resolution: During discussion on the item, Professor Ranjan Chakrabarti, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Dr. J.K. Nandi, Registrar (Actg.), Professor Tirthankar Das Purkayastha, Dean (Actg.), Faculty Councils for Postgraduate Studies in Arts & Commerce did not want to participate in this regard and wanted to leave the meeting. The members of the Executive Council (EC) requested them to continue to stay in the meeting but gave them liberty to abstain from discussion in this regard. The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Registrar (Actg.) and Dean (Actg.),

Faculty Councils for Postgraduate Studies in Arts & Commerce thereafter abstained from any further discussion taken upon the issue.

The aforesaid two letters of Dr. Indrani Datta (Chaudhuri) dated 25.05.2015 and 31.05.2015 were placed before the Executive Council (EC). The EC members unanimously resolved that in view of the order of the Hon'ble High Court dated 01.06.2015 extending the time of completion of enquiry proceeding against Dr. Indrani Datta (Chaudhuri) and further having furnished reply to the enquiry report the EC would take up Dr. Indrani Datta (Chaudhuri)'s reply to the same on its priority basis and the EC further resolved that the aforesaid letters from Dr. Datta (Chaudhuri) do not call for any response at this juncture.

Thereafter, the EC takes up the Enquiry report of the Enquiry Officer, Dr. Siddhartha Majumdar dated 21/04/2015 and the reply/ comments of Dr. Datta (Chaudhuri) submitted by her to the Enquiry Report. The EC members thereupon deliberated in details on each charge and the findings of the Enquiry Officer on each charge vis-à-vis the reply of Dr. Datta (Chaudhuri) to the Enquiry Report. The EC also concluded as to the awarding of punishment to Dr. Datta (Chaudhuri) on the basis of their findings. The detailed findings of the EC are recorded in separate sheets and forms part of this proceeding.

Considering the findings of the EC as recorded above it is hereby resolved;

- a) That nine future cumulative annual or otherwise increments which will fall due with effect from 30/06/2015 (forenoon) to Dr. Indrani Datta (Chaudhuri) irrespective of the basic to be enjoyed by her at any pay band shall be withheld without affecting her promotion. In case of Dr. Datta (Chaudhuri)'s future promotion, fitment may be allowed without any increment, subject to fulfillment of all prerequisites as per the UGC guidelines and positive recommendation by the duly constituted screening or selection committee.
- b) That as a consequence of the award of punishment as above, the suspension of Dr. Indrani Datta (Chaudhuri) stands withdrawn with effect from 29/06/2015 (afternoon). Dr. Indrani Datta (Chaudhuri) will not be entitled to any other payments for her period of suspension other than the amount already received by her by way of subsistence allowances. Dr. Indrani Datta (Chaudhuri)'s suspension having been withdrawn she may be requested to join her services as Assistant Professor in the Department of English, Vidyasagar University on 30/06/2015 (forenoon) or on any working day thereafter not exceeding three days from the date as stated herein above.

Affiliation : 07.

To consider the proposal bearing letter No. Gims/Mid/248/AL/15 dated 13.05.2015 submitted by the Director, Gourav Institute of Management Science, Midnapore pertaining to extending affiliation for conducting B. Voc. courses in Travel, Tourism & Hospitality and Office Management & Secretarial Practice respectively from the academic session 2015-2016.

Resolution: Consideration of the item was deferred.

Recommendation : 08. To consider the recommendation of the Selection Committee for promotion of Dr. Raj Kumar Kothari, Department of Political Science with Rural Administration of this University to the post of Professor from Reader under the Career Advancement Scheme of UGC.

Resolution: Consideration of the item was deferred.



Renewal of Contract :09. To consider the letter dated 05.05.2015 submitted by Shri Debajit Guha, Junior Peon (Contractual), Department of Santali pertaining to renewal of contract service for a further period.

Resolution: The Executive Council of Vidyasagar University considered the letter dated 05.05.2015 submitted by Shri Debajit Guha, Junior Peon(Contractual), Department of Santali pertaining to renewal of his contract service for a further period.

Resolved that on the basis of the satisfactory performance during his contract period, the contract service of Shri Guha in the post of Junior Peon, Department of Santali be renewed for a further period of two years with effect from 25.06.2015. Resolved also that the pay of the incumbent be fixed as per the University rule.
